Weigh-In:	Weigh-ins to be decided after the official entry closing date.
Registration/ Kit Check	Lifters are encouraged to register on Friday 26 th 6pm–8pm at the venue. However, there will also be registration. The kit check is the responsibility of national federations, however question regarding equipment check is possible before youre competition starts
Entry Fees:	€80 for first lift €30 for an additional lift As per the WDFPF regulations, each nation will be liable to pay 50% of the entry fee for all lifters entered who do not compete to the organisers.

To Enter:	All lifters must submit their entry forms & entry fees to their National Federation for inclusion on the National Team List. The entry fees for the whole national team must be paid at registration by a representative of that nation.
Closing Date:	All national team lists must reach their organisers by 27/10/2021. National Federations MUST set an earlier closing date to ensure they receive all entries prior to submitting them to the organisers. The entry forms & release from liability signed by the lifters must be handed in at registration.
Reception:	There will be a reception on Friday 26 th November 2021 at the Old Coach Inn after congress. Details to follow.
Celebration Party:	A celebration function will be held on the Sunday night 28 th November 2021. Details will be provided closer to the event.
Hotels	The Glencarn Hotel will be the designated hotel for this event. It has many rooms and is providing lifters with a special rate. Twin/double approx €100 includes a full breakfast. Single €50 includes full breakfast. Room only options for less are available.
	The Hotel has a leisure centre including a fitness suite.
	The hotel is located in the town centre and is 5 min walk from Iontas venue.
